What is the overall deductible?	In-Network: Individual \$500 / Family \$1,000. Out-of-Network: Individual \$1,500 / Family \$3,000.	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <u>providers</u> up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u> , each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>deductible</u> .
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?	Yes. <u>Preventive care</u> is covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> .	This <u>plan</u> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <u>deductible</u> amount. But a <u>copayment</u> or <u>coinsurance</u> may apply. For example, this <u>plan</u> covers certain <u>preventive services</u> without <u>cost sharing</u> and before you meet your <u>deductible</u> . What is the out-of-pocket limit for this plan?	Individual \$3,000 / Family \$6,000. Out-of-Network: Individual \$6,000 / Family \$12,000. This plan has a separate <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> of \$1,500/ Individual or \$3,000/ Family for <u>prescription drugs</u> .	The <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> is the most you could pay in a year for covered services.
