International SOS

ISOS is a global travel health resource for Citi business travelers.

ISOS is not an insurance plan that covers medical expenses but it coordinates claims with:

- ACE, Citi's business travel medical insurance plan (BTM) which provides non-routine and emergency medical coverage for non-expat employees and dependents when traveling on business outside assignment or home country
- AETNA GLOBAL, Citi's expat medical insurance plan which provides medical coverage for expatriates and dependents on assignment

All employees traveling on business should contact ISOS (1 215-244-1740) for guidance prior to accessing health care abroad if they become ill or have a medical question or concern.

Please be ready to provide your GEID or SOEID. ISOS provides the following resources to all global business travelers including expatriates and shortterm assignees:

Pre-travel:

- E-mail at the time of booking with pre-travel guidance on required/recommended immunizations and country specific health information if travel includes an area of elevated health risk
- Phone consultations to provide up-to-date advice and resources for required/ recommended immunizations
- Proof of evacuation and repatriation insurance coverage -- See Global Business Travel Health on Citi For You
- Proof of Business Travel Medical Coverage (BTM) by ACE See Global Business Travel Health on Citi For You

During Travel:
